NSW Slovenian Community Award 2013 The Hon. Tanya Pliberšek MP

OUTSTANDING ACHIEVER OF SLOVENIAN BACKGROUND IN AUSTRALIAN POLITICS



Tanya Pliberšek je bila rojena v družini slovenskih priseljencev Roze in Jožeta Pliberška, ki sta prispela v Australijo v zgodnjih petdesetih letih prejšnjega stoletja. Tanya je bila drugi otrok od treh v družini.

Obiskovala je Jannali Girls High School, kjer je postala vodja razreda (Dux), nadaljevala v "University of Technology, Sydney, in končala univerzo kot "Bachelor of Arts" in dodatno "Masters in Public Policy and Politics at Macquarie University". Pliberškova družina je imela zelo močne korenine v slovenski domovini in to povezanost so starši posredovali tudi otrokom.

Tanya je prvič obiskala Slovenijo, ko je bila stara štiri leta in ljubezen do prelepe dežele njenih staršev se je okrepila z vsakim ponovnim obiskom. Ljubezen do Slovenije in slovensko dediščino je Tanya posredovala svojim trem otrokom, Louisu, Anni in Josephu, ki so v stalni povezavi s starimi starši vzljubili vse, kar je slovenskega - glasbo, hrano in običaje. Otroci se poizkušajo naučiti tudi slovenskega jezika, kolikor jim razmere dopuščajo.

Tanya had shown very early a great aptitude for politics. After graduating, she worked for the Domestic Violence Unit at the Office for the Status and Advancement of Women in New South Wales, and later in the office of Senator Bruce Childs. She was elected the Member of Parliament for Sydney in 1998, and re-elected five times.

She was Shadow Minister for Work, Family and Community, Shadow Minister for Youth and Early Childhood Education and Shadow Minister Assisting the Leader on the Status of Women since October 2004. This portfolio was retitled Shadow Minister for Child Care, Youth and Women in June 2005.

Following the Shadow Ministerial reshuffle in December 2006 (when Kevin Rudd assumed the leadership of the Federal Parliamentary Labor Party, Tanya was promoted to be Shadow Minister for Human Services, Housing, Youth and Women. Tanya served in both the Rudd and Gillard Governments as Minister for Housing, Minister for Human Services .

In 2013 she became the Deputy Leader of the Opposition and Deputy Leader of the Labor Party while also serving as Shadow Minister for Foreign Affairs and International Development.

While being so busy with her very demanding political career, Tanya is also a wife and a mother to three well-adjusted and well behaved children and also a loving daughter to her widowed mother.

Even with so many demands on her time and work commitments she always tries to do her best to find time to attend important functions in the Slovenian community, where she is always welcome with great love and appreciation.

Brez težav je našel delo v Sydneyu in nato v različnih krajih Australije, vse preden sta se leta 1968 poročila z Lojzko in si ustvarila dom v Seftonu, kjer živita še sedaj. Lojzka je za tem ostala doma in skrbela za troje otrok.

OUTSTANDING AUSTRALIAN SLOVENIAN ACHIEVEMENTS IN MEDIA AND PRESERVING SLOVENIAN HERITAGE



Florijan se je rodil leta 1949 v Bohinjski Češnjici v Sloveniji.
Po zaključenem šolanju je deloval kot komercialni fotograf in grafični oblikovalec.

Koncem devetdesetih let je svojo profesionalno pot nadaljeval v Avstraliji, kjer redno obnavlja znanje s področja foto-video tehnike in grafičnega oblikovanja.

S slovensko skupnostjo v Avstraliji se je prvič delovno povezal v letu 1994 in nato v letu 1996, ko je prevzel vodenje časopisa Glas Slovenije.
V letu 1998 je osnoval medmrežno spletišče Stičišče Avstralskih Slovencev (www.glasslovenije.com.au), ki je namenjen slovenski skupnosti v Avstraliji in s katero skrbi za redno obveščanje naše skupnosti o dogajanjih doma in po svetu.

Od leta 2007 Florijan zastopa Avstralske Slovence kot član Sveta za Slovence po Svetu pri Vladi Republike Slovenije.

In the late 1990's Florijan was one of the founders of Slovenian Media House, gathering and documenting life stories of Australian Slovenians, first on videotape and most recently in digital form. Early in March 1996 he presented to the Slovenian National Council an idea to establish Slovenian archives in Sydney. Although it took a few years HASA NSW was established in 2004, and over the next decade his professional assistance and guidance has been greatly appreciated. For special celebrations of important anniversaries of the various Slovenian organizations, he has produced video presentations and/or wall to wall exhibitions of historical photos and documents. This has been done with the cooperation of HASA NSW archivists and also from his own records. In the same formats he has helped to present the life stories of Slovenian community members to be preserved after events within HASA NSW archives. Some of his video presentations and exhibitions have also been exhibited in Ljubljana, Slovenia and broadcast on Slovenian TV. Also, Florijan has worked with ZRC Koper and Ljubljana at CRP 2002, with the first presentation of digital

Due to his efforts and under his guidance a process of digitisation of the HASA NSW archives started in the year 2012. The Digital archive for Australian Slovenians and Slovenians around the globe, was published on 3rd May 2014 /www.da-slo.com.au, www.da-slo.si/.

archives and video documentation of the life and work of Slovenian migrants in Australia.

He was also the producer and broadcaster of the Slovenian program on TV Channel 31 in Sydney and Melbourne for a number of years and has produced many documentaries about Slovenians in Australia. Apart from the newspaper Glas Slovenije, Florijan designed, edited and produced a number of publications, booklets, pamphlets and posters to accommodate the needs of Slovenian organisations in Australia. Aside from his professional work he has a strong affinity for the needs of old, sick and vulnerable people and he always spends a lot of time and effort helping them, always avoiding the spotlight on his good works - and we respect him for that!
