MAGIC BLUE MOUNTAINS

Departure from Triglav Panthers at 7.00am.

Travelling along the Nepean River, admiring the premier thoroughbred horse studs, Roderick Lodge and Princess Farm, owned by Bart Cummings, together with Orange orchards and Turf farms.

Across the river into the land once occupied by Darug Aboriginals, passing the sacred area hiding "the Flight of the Kangaroo" Rock Engraving and enjoy MORNING TEA AT THE SPECTACULAR HAWKESBURY LOOKOUT overlooking the Nepean river, Cumberland plains and Sydney City Skyline over 50km .

We then travel west along the Bells Line of Rd admiring the bush land scenery and sheer cliffs. When we reach the HERITAGE ZIG ZAG RAILWAY, we step back in time and board the STEAM TRAIN for a memorable 1.5 hrs journey descending the Western Slopes of the Blue Mountains Escarpment into Lithgow.



We reboard the coach and travel on to Govett's Leap to BRIDAL FALLS named for its tall water cascade and Spectacular view.

We have Lunch in ECO LODGE nestled in the Blue Mountains Wilderness. Sit down to enjoy a HEARTY 2 COURSE MEAL followed by Tea /Coffee and fruit platters. Relax around the sunken lounge and open fire or venture outside on the timber wrap around verandas to feed the native birds and animals.

Our last stop is at the delightful BLUE MOUNTAINS CHOCOLATE FACTORY where we sample MILK, WHITE AND DARK CHOCOLATE with over 60 different handmade chocolates. Top it off with some real HOME MADE ICE CREAM before we descend the once impassable Hills and return home after our discovery of the Blue Mountains Magic.
