Štefan in Ana Šernek, oba doma iz Slovenskega Prekmurja, sta zelo poznana in spoštovana slovenska rojaka v Sydneyu, saj sta se hitro po njunem prihodu v Avstralijo vključila v slovensko skupnost. Obiskovala sta slovenske maše in sodelovala pri drugih kulturnih in zabavnih aktivnostih v Paddingtonu, že leta 1966. pa sta postala člana Slovenskega društva Sydney. He was part of the 1st Slovenian Orchestra and played at many community and private functions, and also at the Slovenian Youth concerts. Stefan and Ana became members of the Slovene Association Sydney 1966. Stefan was first a committee member and then a president from 1984 to 1994. He was also a president of the Hunter's Group for 15 years.

During his presidency, he led and supervised the building of the current premises at Wetherill Park, which was opened in 1989. A lot of woodwork at the Club is Stefan's work. At the same time he was encouraging the cultural and social community life. He organised and sang in a number of choirs and is now leading the Trio SDS singers. He is also responsible for current cultural and social activities at SDS.

From 1982 Ana has helped with the preparations of the hall of SDS, cleaning, looking after the floral arrangements and doing the laundry for SDS. During the building of the current premises, she would help to organise the food and drinks for the workers. No matter what the weather, she was there till the roof went up.

Later she spent much time and energy in all areas of the club: greeting guests, work in the bar, cleaning, kitchen work and much more. In November of 2007, both Ana and Stefan, were voted in as committee members again. This time we find Stefan once again in charge of social and cultural events and Ana helping wherever help is needed.

Štefan je rojen 12.12.1936 v vasi Črenšovci v Prekmurju v Sloveniji kot 13. otrok. Šolo je obiskoval v Črenšovcih in končal nižjo gimnazijo. Izučil se je za mizarja, ker je njegov oče imel mizarsko obrt in tako so se tudi sinovi učili mizarstva. Šolo je končal na mizarski zbornici na Ptuju. Kot mladinec se je veliko ukvarjal s športom, bil navdušen pevec in plesalec. Sodeloval je pri mladinskem pevskem zboru v Črenšovcih. Bil je tudi najboljši plesalec ruskega plesa KAZAČOK.

V času svoje učne dobe je spoznal svojo ženo ANICO KOREN. Ana je rojena 12.6.1938 na Srednji Bistrici v Prekmurju. Leta 1956 sta odšla v Avstrijo in se tam poročila leta 1957. Še isto leto sta prišla v Avstralijo, v Melbourne 15.4.1957 in naprej v hostel Greta v NSW. Štefan in Ana sta se takoj vključila v življenje nastajajoče slovenske skupnosti. Z ženo sta redno hodila k slovenskim nedeljskim in prazničnim mašam, kakor tudi na razne prireditve. Štefan rad raztegne harmoniko. Bil je član prvega slovenskega orkestra, ki ga je tedaj v Paddingtonu organiziral p. Odilo Hajnšek. Igral je na več porokah, plesih, prireditvah in tudi na slovenskih – mladinskih koncertih. Že od leta 1966 je član Slovenskega društva Sydney, bil je član odbora, od leta 1984 do 1994 predsednik Društva in 15 let tudi predsednik Lovske družine, ki je delovala od leta 1980 do 2006. Kot predsednik je vodil gradnjo sedanjega doma Slovenskega društva v Wetheril Parku, ki je bil odprt 22.4.1989. Hkrati je skrbel za kulturno in družabno življenje, za moški pevski zbor

SDS, zbor Lipa in sedaj za Trio SDS.

Ana je od leta 1982 pripravljala dvorano na Slovenskem društvu, čistila, prala prte, zavese, kuhinjsko perilo, skrbela za cvetje. Od novembra 2007 sta oba, Štefan in Ana, spet v odboru Društva. Štefan skrbi za kulturno in družabno življenje, Ana sprejema goste, prodaja loterijske listke in postori, kar je potrebno. Vse delo do danes opravljata popolnoma prostovoljno.

Štefan je tudi v Avstraliji delal kot mizar. Leta 1968 je odprl svoje podjetje SERNIK KITCHEN AND CABINET- MAKER. Žena Ana je bila zaposlena v podjetju kot knjigovodja. Veliko opreme v dvorani in prostorih SDS je delo njegovih rok. Sedaj sta oba v pokoju, podjetje pa vodi sin Štefan, ki je prav tako odličen harmonikar, bil je prvak v igranju harmonike v Avstraliji in še danes nastopa na odru v duetu.

Lani, 4.2.2007, sta praznovala zlato poroko pri Sv. Rafaelu v Merrylandsu. Bog ju živi še vrsto let!
