Andrew Žičkar is a second generation Slovenian Australian. He was born in Wollongong in 1966 as the youngest child in the family. When he was 12, his father died and his mother had to bring up four children on her own.

Andrew was involved in the Slovenian community from early on. He attended Slovenian school, taught by Sister Mirjam who would visit from the Slovenian Mission Merrylands. In 1979 he started playing keyboard at the Slovenian Holy Services, held then, at Villa Maria in Wollongong. He was also a member of the youth choir "Zlati Glas" (Golden Voice). After their own church was acquired in 1983 by Club Planica - Wollongong, Andrew continued helping at the church, playing at the services, helping the priest when needed, and also taking care of the church and the surroundings.

Andrew is very good with electronics and takes care of anything needed at the Club Planica in this field. For the last four years, he has been a member of the Club's Committee. He is a very good organiser, taking care of functions and visitors, such as the 2008 World Youth Day visitors from Slovenia. He organised the accommodation, transport and entertainment for them, while they were staying in Wollongong.

He likes to wear his national costume for special occasions at both the church and club functions. He is always available to help, whenever needed.

MARGARET HATEŽIČ

NSW - Slovenian Outstanding Senior Citizen of the Year 2009

PLANICA - WOLLONGONG



Margaret Hatežič was born in 1944 in Maribor, Slovenia. The life in Maribor just after the war was not easy. The whole family, mother, father, Margaret and her two sisters crossed the border into Austria in 1957, and they decided to go to Australia. They arrived in Melbourne on 2nd November 1957.

Margaret's father found work at the ironworks in Port Kembla, while Margaret worked in a restaurant in Melbourne. After her father built a house in the Wollongong area, Margaret joined the family there.

At that time Slovenians in the Wollongong area were organised as the Slovenian Association »Danica«. Margaret's family joined in the activities, attended Slovenian Holy Masses, social gatherings and other functions.

In 1965, Margaret married Marjan Hatežič. They had two daughters and a son, who were all brought up in the Slovenian tradition, attending Slovenian school and speaking Slovenian at home. The whole family was very active in the current Slovenian club »Planica« and the original association »Danica». The children performed in the club's choir and at club functions and celebrations. Margaret was at first the club's treasurer and later their secretary for ten years, up until 2009, when her health problems forced her to quit her work.

Margaret also started the archives for the Slovenian Community in Wollongong and gathered a great number of histories of Australian Slovenians from the Wollongong area. To do her archivist job well, she also attended the archivist seminar in Slovenia.

In 2008, when the Slovenian church of All Saints in Figtree celebrated its 25th anniversary, Margaret compiled the history of the church and wrote a book »V zavetju vseh svetnikov«, which included a great number of photos and stories of the events and of people involved with the church. The book, written partly in English and partly in Slovenian, was a great success among Slovenians in Australia and brought Margaret a lot of recognition in the circles of historians in Slovenia.

Margaret Hatežič je dobra, zavedna Slovenka, ki nikoli ni pozabila svojih korenin in je tudi svoje otroke vzgojila v slovenskem duhu. S svojim delom v društvu Planica in z zbiranjem in ohranjevanjem slovenske zgodovine v Australiji, je napravila neizmerno delo za slovensko skupnost, za katero res zasluži posebno spoštovanje in priznanje.

NSW - Slovenian Outstanding Volunteer of the Year 2009

TIVOLI - NEWCASTLE



Cilka Princic, born Jamar, was born in Jesenice, Slovenia, to father Ciril Jamar and mother Franciska. After finishing primary and secondary school and 3 years of trade school, she became a qualified gents and ladies hairdresser.

On 10th February 1962 she married Richard Princic by proxy and arrived in Australia in October 1962 on the ship "Roma." To comply with Australian law, she officially married Richard Princic on 22nd December 1962 at the St. Laurence O'Toole church at Broadmeadow. They made their home at Mayfield on the outskirts of Newcastle. Their three children have all completed university degrees and now have their own families.

Cilka became involved with the Austral Slovenian Society "Tivoli", Newcastle Inc, soon after she arrived in Australia. She joined her husband, who was involved with "Tivoli" from the beginning. When he passed away in June 1999, she replaced him as a committee member, later becoming vice-president, and in 2008, as acting president. She always did more than her share of work. She especially helped with the preparation of exhibitions, assisted in the kitchen and in preparing the hall at times of celebrations such as the 40th and 50th anniversaries of "Tivoli". She is also a committee member of HASA-NSW and has been helping, mainly in the kitchen, at the last three reunions.

Cilka does a lot of quiet community work and over the years has helped many people regardless of their nationality, colour or creed. She has often visited people in hospitals or nursing homes, accompanied many people to a doctor, Centrelink, banks or other places, helping people with language difficulties. Although, initially she had problems with the language herself, she was never afraid to go into any office to find out whatever she needed to know to help someone. If someone was lonely, they didn't have to come to her, she would get on a bus and find them. Often she would spend hours talking on the phone just to make someone feel better.

CILKA PRINCIC



Cilka PRINCIC roj. Jamar se je rodila na Jesenicah, Slovenija, 15. oktobra 1941 kot drugi otrok očetu Cirilu in materi Frančiški roj. Mubi. Brat Jože živi v domači hiši na Jesenicah. Po končani osnovni šoli in takratni nižji gimnaziji se je izučila frizerskega poklica, kar je delala vse dokler ni prišla v Avstralijo.

10. februarja 1962 se je v Jesenicah po zastopniku poročila z Rihardom Prinčičem, čeprav ga preje nikoli v življenju ni videla. Postala je tako imenovana »proxy

bride, « kar se je v tisti dobi veliko dogajalo, saj je marsikateri mlad slovenski fant pripeljal dekle v Avstralijo. Cilka je prišla v Avstralijo oktobra 1962 na ladji »Roma« in se po avstralskem zakonu uradno poročila 22. decembra 1962 v katoliški cerkvi sv. Lovrenca O'Toole v Broadmeadowu. Dom in družino sta si ustvarila v Mayfieldu, predmestje Newcastla. V zakonu so se rodili trije otroci: Lilianna, Diana in Edward. Vsi trije so dokončali univerzo in imajo danes svoje družine. Po Rihardovi smrti, 29. junija 1999, za rakom, se je Cilka preselila v Lambton, kjer še danes živi blizu hčerke Diane.

Rihard Prinčič je bil delaven pri društvu od tistega prvega večera, 19. oktobra 1958, ko se je Slovensko društvo v Newcastlu ustanovili, in vse do njegove smrti. Dolga leta je bil odbornik. Ko je prišla Cilka, se je ravno tako vključila v dejavnost društva in sodelovala, kjer koli je bilo potrebno. Po Rihardovi smrti je postala član odbora in pozneje prevzela podpredsedniško mesto. Po smrti g. Klopčiča 2008, je začasno prevzela predsedniško mesto. Leta 2004, je postala tudi član odbora Zgodovinskih arhivov za slovenske Avstralce za NSW. Veliko je sodelovala predvsem pri pripravah večjih društvenih obletnicah, posebno ob 50. letnici društva, kjer je poleg drugega, pomagala tudi pri pripravi slikovne razstave. Pri vseh večjih proslavah, je oblekla narodno nošo, tudi v Sydneyu, kadar je bilo potrebno. Je dober organizator in oseba, na katero se človek vedno lahko zanese 110 procetno.

Cilka Prinčic pa ne deluje samo v slovenski skupnosti. Njeno največje delo skozi vsa leta je bila pomoč velikemu številu ljudi, ne glede na narodnost, religijo, bogastvo ali siromaštvo. Niti pomisli ne, a je človek Slovenec, Hrvat, Srb, Filipinec, Kitajc, ker za njo je vedno važen le človek sam. Šla je z ljudmi na banko, na občino, na Centrelik, skratka vsepovsod. Nikoli se ni ustrašila iti v katero koli pisarno, čeprav ji je bil angleški jezik na začetka tudi težaven. Tako dolgo je govorila, da so ljudje dosegli, kar so želeli. Če je bil kdo osamljen ali razočaran, je včasih prebila ure, da je potolažila človeka v stiski. Veliko je obiskovala ljudi po domovih, tudi po bolnicah in domovih za ostarele. Njena družina niso samo njeni otroci in sorodniki, temveč veliko več. Za njo so družina vsi, ki jih je kdaj koli v življenje vzela pod njeno okrilje, jim darovala čas, trud in pomoč. Z njemim dobrodelnim delom še danes nadaljuje.

Cilka si vsekakor zasluži predlagano priznanje – NSW Slovenian of the Year Award – Volunteer of the Year 2009 - Newcastle.

Cilka Princic b. Jamar was born in Jesenice, Slovenia, as a second child to father Ciril Jamar and mother Franciska b. Mubi. After finishing primary and secondary schooling, she became an apprentice and after attending a trade school for 3 years, became a qualified gents and ladies hairdresser.

On 10 February 1962, she married Richard Princic by proxy, a man, she had know only by photos and letters but never met or seen before. There were many such marriages at the time, because young men, living and

working in Australia, wanted brides from their home country. Cilka arrived to Australia in October 1962 on a boat "Roma" and, to comply with the Australian law, officially married Richard Princic on 22. December 1962 at the St. Lawrence O'Tool church at Broadmeadow. They made their home at Mayfield on the outskirts of Newcastle. They had three children – Lilianna, Diana and Edward. All three completed university degrees and have their own families. Richard passed away on 29 June 1999 and Cilka moved to Lambton, to be closer to her daughter Diana.

Cilka became involved with the Austral Slovenian Society "Tivoli", Newcastle Inc, soon after she arrived to Australia. She joined Richard, who was involved with "Tivoli" ever since it was establish in 1958. She helped with whatever help was required. When Richard passed away, she replaced him as the committee member, later becoming the vice-president. In late 2008, she also became acting president. She always did more than her share of work. She especially helpëd with the preparations of the exhibitions, assisted in the kitchen and preparing the hall at times such as 40th and 50th anniversary of "Tivoli. As we were growing up in the 60's and early 70's, mum was always helping others. In those days language was a barrier to many migrants as they were having trouble grasping the language ,fortunately mum took it upon herself to learn and she learnt well. She was able to engage most appointments wether they be legal , medical or of a social nature. Mum was able to effectively interpret for those in need despite the fact that she was only relatively new to the language herself.

Her compassion for other people was endless and to this day she maintains a high profile for those in need within her community. Our dinner table was always available to anyone that popped in even when I myself invited someone who was left alone on holidays and special occasions. It was my mother who as a tireless worker helping those less fortunate people that inspired my own view of the world and sharing what we had with others.

The giving that I refer to is multifaceted ,the emotional support she is able to provide to others comes from experience and living life to the fullest. If she didn't know something she would certainly find out. If someone was lonely she would spend hours on the phone taking time out of her day to make sure that they were ok. If they wouldn't come to her she would get on a bus and find them .The world held no boundaries to anyone needing my mother.

My mothers thoughtfulness and efforts have always been a quiet contribution to many .She was never one to advertise her efforts and was just happy knowing that she could do something to help others. There were no accolades and fanfare ,just the knowing .

I think if you ask yourself what is your greatest achievement in life hers would be her family. This family is large. It is not only what we consider to be a traditional family, hers would be those throughout her lifetime that she has taken into her fold and has dedicated time ,effort and support and certainly easing life's ups and downs to those in need.

NSW - Slovenian Outstanding Volunteer of the Year 2009

SLOVENIAN ASSOCIATION SYDNEY



ROBERT FISHER is a second generation Australian Slovenian, son of Ludvik and Sonja Fisher. His father Ludvik arrived in Australia in 1964 after finishing trade school in Maribor. Robert's mother, Sonja, arrived in Australia in 1971, married Ludvik and they bought a house in Merrylands, where they still live today.

Robert was born in 1978. The family regularly attended the Slovenian church in Merrylands. Robert became an altar boy at the age of 8 and served for nine years. At the same time he was attending Saturday Slovenian school - Slomškova šola - at the church, and also took jazz dancing classes.

At the age of 12, Robert joined the SDS folk dancing group and performed with them for many years at the club's cultural and social events and celebrations. He also joined the Slovenian Drama Group in Merrylands, starting with the junior parts and later progressing into the roles of the main characters as young lovers in Slovenian comedies, performed in Sydney, Melbourne and elsewhere.

During the 2000 Olympics, he provided sound equipment and electronic support for the Slovenia House, Sydney. He also helped other Slovenian clubs with their sound systems. Robert performed at the Slovenian Youth Concerts with the band "The Big Bang Theory" and for number of years with the Slovenian Dancing Group.

In January 1999, Robert joined the Committee of the Slovenian Association Sydney and worked first as a voluntary secretary/licensee till November 2005, he was then elected the president /licensee of the Club, a position he held till November 2006.

HERMAN ŠARKAN

HERMAN ŠARKAN was born in the village Domojinci in Prekmurje, Slovenia, as the youngest of five children. The village was almost completely destroyed during the war. After the war, he found work in various places in Slovenia and in 1956 he crossed the border to Austria with a group of friends. After a short stay in the camp in Austria, the group came to Australia in early 1957. First they were sent to camp Greta, then to Villawood, and later to another camp in Unanderra.

Herman found work in Sydney and 1961 married a girl from his home area by proxy. Gizela arrived in Australia in 1963. They bought a house in Merrylands, where Herman still lives with his son Peter. Gisela died after a long illness in 2007.

The whole Šarkan family have been and still are involved with the Slovenian community, first with the Slovenian Association Sydney and later with the Slovenian Mission in Merrylands. Herman helped with the building of the church and the church hall. For more than 30 years he has been acting as an usher in the church, collecting the contributions every Sunday. He has always helped with repairs, especially with metalwork as well as other work around the place - preparing the hall, serving in the bar, taking an active part in processions, preparing the church's periodical Rafael, or any other voluntary duty as needed. Herman and his wife Gizela, often provided food for official visitors to the church and for years provided flowers from their own garden for special occasions like weddings, christenings and funerals. Herman also acted as a driver, using his own car and at his own expense, for the priests and visiting dignitaries. Herman still helps as much as he can at the Slovenian Mission Merrylands and has never refused help to anyone in need.

Herman and Gizela also brought up their son Peter to be active in the Slovenian community, attending Slovenian school, acting as an altar server at church for many years, being part of the Dance group and the Slovenian Drama Group.

Ivo Bavčar was born in Ajdovščina in Primorska region, which for many years belonged to Italy. After the World war II, he spent two years in Germany and Italy, then came to Australia. At first, in 1949, he worked in the forests of West Australia and later joined his parents Ivan and Franciska in Sydney.

In 1960 he returned home to find a Slovenian wife. With luck on his side, he fell in love with Doroteja in his home town. They married at the end of 1960 and came to Australia with the intention to stay just ten years.

They lived in Farfield and became involved with the Slovenian Association Sydney, helping a lot. Ivo even became a president for a while.

With their three children, Mirjam, Judith and Bogdan, the whole Bavčar family also became very much involved with the Slovenian Mission at Merrylands. Teja was for many years a member of the church mixed choir until she had to stop for health reasons. She still takes part in the prayer group, specially at the meetings of the group, and at funerals. Tania Smrdel was born in Blacktown in 1978, the daughter of Mira and Miro Smrdel. Tania's involvement within the Slovenian community began early in life. She attended "Slomskova šola" as a child, learning the Slovenian language and even at that time participated on stage in Slovenian cultural functions and mother's and father's day celebrations.

Later, for a decade or so, she was part of the Folkloric Dance Group at SDS and has been frequently the Master of Ceremonies at various cultural performances in the community.

During this time Tania attended Bankstown School of Community Languages and very successfully graduated in the Slovenian language. KARLO SAMSA

NSW- Slovenian Life Time Achievement Award



Karlo Samsa came from village Prelože in the Primorska region of Slovenia. He arrived in Australia in 1966 with his wife Hedvika, baby daughter Yolanda, his mother Karolina and younger brother Vinko at the invitation of his two older brothers who had come to Australia years earlier.

Clever and hard working, Karlo soon found work. Their second child Dusan was born in 1967. A little later, they built a house and next to the house a bocce court, where a great number of other men from Primorska started gathering on Sundays. His house became a social centre for Slovenians, until a friend mentioned the newly founded Club Triglav at St Johns Park in 1972.

After his first visit to the new Triglav Club, Karlo took with him his truck, his brother Vinko and a few other helpers. They brought sand there and built bocce courts at Triglav, an attraction that brought more and more people to play on Sundays.

Karlo became a member of the Club's Committee from the start. He was also the president of the club from 1977 to 1984. He organised the building of the club and anything else that needed to be built. Without his leadership and expertise the Club Triglay might not exist today.

When they planned the club's proper building, they had to change the layout of the bocce courts. Karlo and Vinko personally built six courts, with proper foundations, concrete floors and then brick by brick. Later other volunteers joined them and built fences around the courts. The club was finished in 1982. A year later, they decided to put a roof over the bocce courts. The work was finished with a great opening in 1983, when bocce players from all around Australia took part in the opening competition. Soon after, when all the planning and building was finished, Karlo decided, that his work was done. For a while he worked as a manager of the newly built club and then he decided to let others do their turn, and to spend more time with his family.

They bought a caravan at the lake in the Snowy Mountains and even then Karlo spent half of his free time helping his friends build annexes and improving their holiday cabins.
