NOTIFICATION OF FINAL NUMBERS ATTENDING

The number of guests in the official party, final guaranteed number attending, seating plans and table numbers are required by 10.00 a.m. two days preceding the function and the Union will not be responsible for any disruption resulting from failure to give this information.
